3. Ride-on or Walking machines

This model allows the operator to steer the machine all-around obstructions and corners efficiently and easily since the operator has a good vantage point. These kinds of floor scrubbing machines come equipped with a two hundred fifty liter water tank plus an equivalent tank to accumulate the filthy water. Walking devices are similar products that could be operated by anybody walking at the back of the equipment and maneuvering the scrubber.
